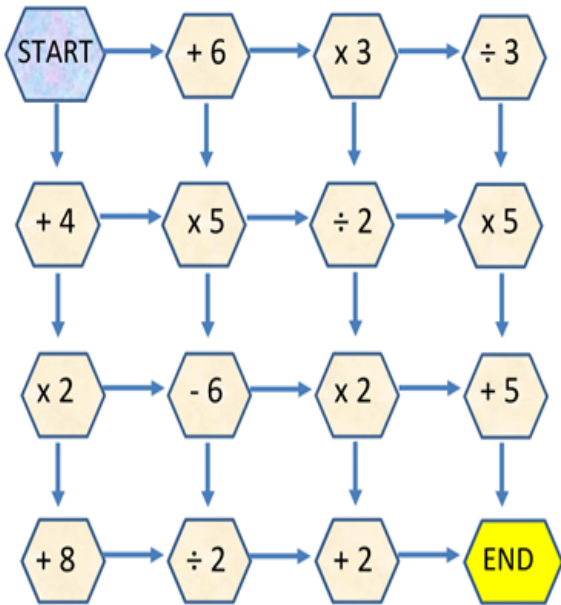
## NUMBER MAZE: TARGET 50

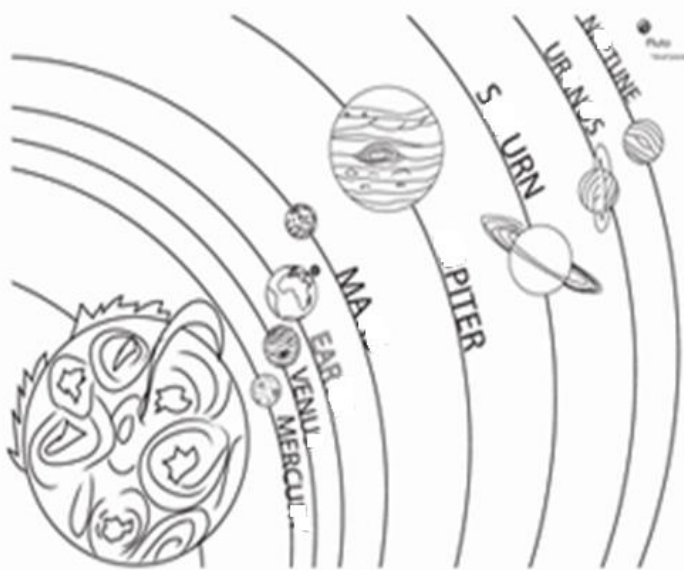
## Multiplication Square Puzzles

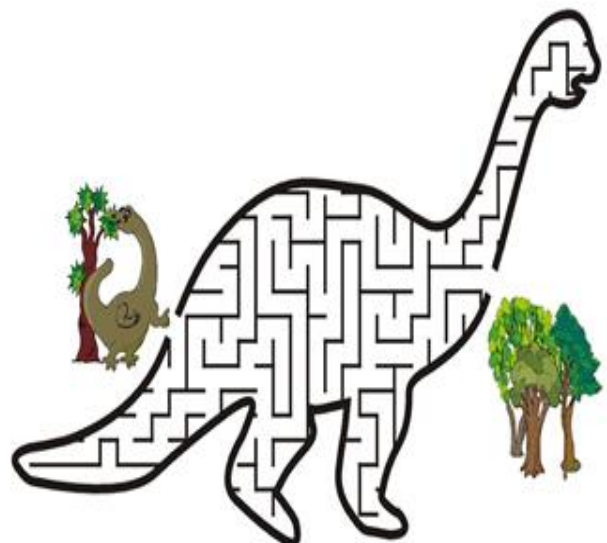

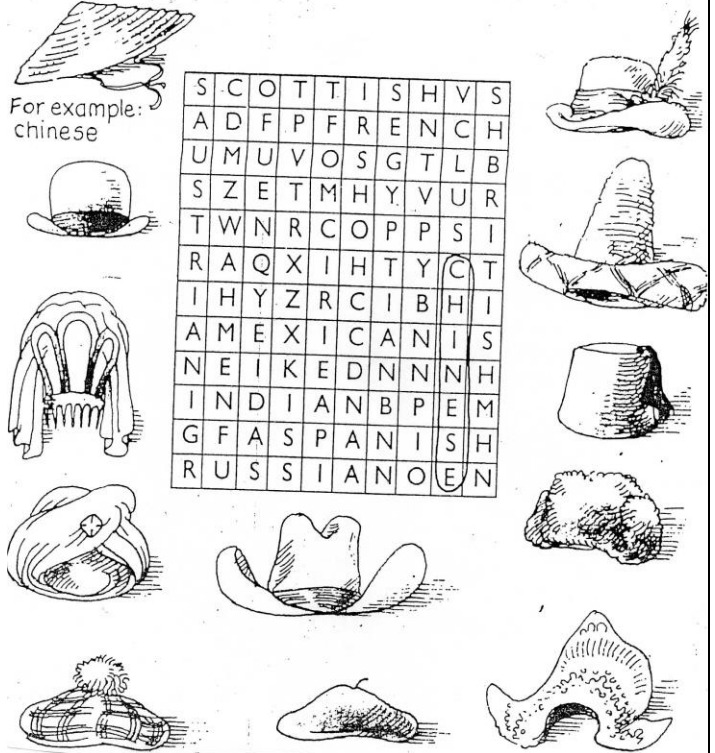
